

SYNOPSIS:

Ken, a former convict turned founder of a San Francisco recovery program, has spent fourteen years atoning for the street life that cost his wife her life. His program brings together MELANIE, an educated woman undone by addiction and a custody battle for her children; AMY, a pregnant teenager fighting to reclaim her son from the system; SAM, a man rebuilding his life under the same roof as his two sons, who deal fentanyl behind his back; BILL, who suspects his charming father is a serial killer; and ERIC, a calm, controlled man with a violent past as a contract killer.

As the group's recoveries intersect with their unresolved pasts, the threads begin to collapse into one another. Sam discovers that his youngest son has turned federal informant against his older brother, and that Sam himself has a bounty on his life from a previous betrayal. Bill's counselor, Kendra, is abducted by Bill's father, a methodical predator who has killed before. And when Eric's son is murdered in a robbery gone wrong, Eric turns his lethal skills toward vengeance, unaware the trail leads directly to Ken's family.

Over a single catastrophic night, the violence converges: Melanie overdoses on fentanyl meant for someone else; Bill confronts his father in a fire that consumes them both; and Eric's retaliation strikes Ken's pregnant daughter and Amy. Ken, the man who built his second life on the promise of peace, is forced back into the violence, where he ends up with a showdown with the police.

A year later, inside a state prison, Sam, the last survivor of the shattered group, faces the consequences of the past one final time.
