

SYNOPSIS:

Former high school football prodigy Bryant, desperate to save his family's struggling farm after his father's death, resorts to burglarizing local estates with his best friend, Tim. During a break-in, Bryant escapes after assaulting a security guard, but Tim is caught. When faced with assault charges, Tim rats Bryant out, and Bryant is sentenced to a maximum-security prison.

Inside prison, Bryant's athletic prowess catches the eye of Angel, a hardened white convict who quickly offers him the coveted quarterback spot for the annual inmate football game. Eager for purpose, Bryant accepts, and Angel becomes both mentor and protector. When Bryant's mother Sarah visits, she meets Angel, sparking an unexpected and complicated bond between them.

After his parole, Angel joins the family farm, appearing every bit the reformed man. He helps the farm flourish and wins over the townsfolk, all while secretly returning to his deadly ways, targeting local prostitutes. When an out-of-state detective warns Bryant about Angel's dark past, Bryant's suspicions grow, especially after noticing bruises on his mother and recalling Tim's fate. He becomes certain that true evil hides beneath Angel's charming facade.

When both the detective and another victim turn up dead, and Bryant is moved to a minimum-security facility, dread sets in: his family is in peril. He orchestrates a bold escape and sprints home, arriving just as Angel holds his loved ones hostage. In a brutal showdown, Bryant defeats Angel, rescuing his mother and family from the clutches of a relentless killer.
